General Orthopaedic Surgery

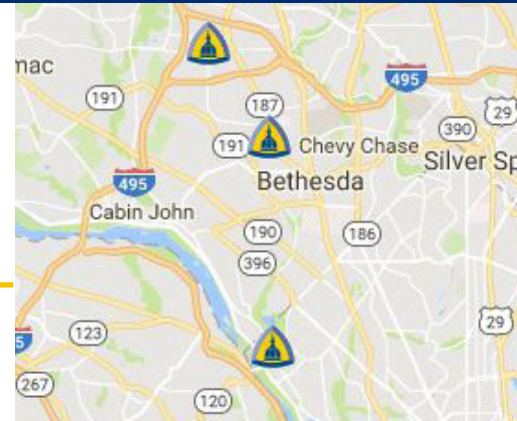

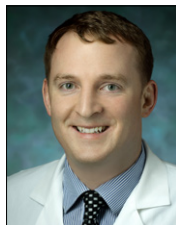
